#### **Terms of Reference**

### **Purpose**

The role of the Strathmore Park Community Action Coalition is to provide strategic direction and leadership to support a community-led development approach in Strathmore Park that identifies shared issues and opportunities to generate local solutions.

#### **Term**

This Terms of Reference is effective from 1 July 2020 and will be ongoing until terminated by agreement between the parties.

## Membership

The Coalition will comprise organisations and people who have an on-going commitment to Strathmore Park, demonstrated through their mahi in and for this place.

The inaugural members of the Coalition are:

Further members may be added to the Coalition with the agreement of members.

#### **Roles and Responsibilities**

The work of the Coalition may include:

- Guardianship of the community consultation work that has occurred (refer summary of 2013-19 consultation)
- Development of community action plans
- Establishment of information sharing vehicles
- Coordination of community projects
- Doing environmental scans to identify gaps/opportunities for new projects

The membership of the Coalition will commit to:

- Attending all scheduled Coalition meetings
- Wholeheartedly and openly contributing information and ideas

The coordination/secretariat functions for the Coalition will be shared by Coalition members on rotation. The manager, Strathmore Park Community Centre Trust, will be the initial coordinator/secretariat, for a period of no less than one year.

Action-focussed work to deliver community action occurs beyond the Coalition itself. This harnesses wider networks and engages people in their area of interest and where they have the energy.

# Meetings

Meetings will be held six monthly for one and a half hours at Kahurangi School, or other location agreed by the members.

### **Amendment**

This Terms of Reference may be amended in writing after consultation and agreement by the Coalition members.
